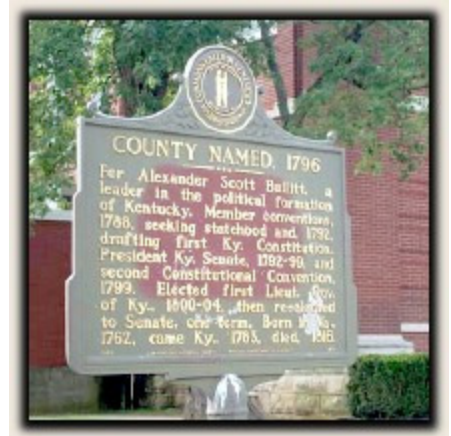

Bernheim Arboretum and Forest: The Official State Arboretum features a 14,000 forest and a landscaped arboretum with 2,000 plants identified in a natural setting.
