VISITOR ATTRACTIONS

Green County Former Courthouse - Known as the oldest existing courthouse west of the Allegheny Mountains, the former Green County Courthouse was begun in 1802 and completed late in 1803. Built in the southeast quadrant of the Public Square, the courthouse replaced a log courthouse constructed shortly after the formation of Green County in 1792. The building was altered in 1869 by closing a balcony that added an upstairs room. A wooden floor was laid over the flag stone floor on the "populace", and a new bell added in 1879. Many noted attorneys practiced law here - among them were Ninion Edwards, President Andrew Jackson and Aaron Harding. At one time 43 attorneys were members of the Greensburg Bar. The building has served many purposes - courthouse, Internal Revenue Office during the Civil War, Ration Board Headquarters during World War II and as the Jane Todd Crawford Library. The "Old Courthouse" has been beautifully restored to its original state and welcomes many visitors to Green County each year. The courthouse is open to visitors most days of the summer months, and as needed by the Green County Historical Society. We encourage you to visit this beautiful building and from there take the self-guided walking tour of Greensburg's historical sites.

Green River Paddle Tour offers canoeing, kayaking, fishing and camping, all in a beautiful location near the Green River. There are year-round cabins, RV hook-ups and shuttle service and canoe rental available. Also, the trail is within walking distance of a National Register Historic District, including the Oldest Courthouse west of the Allegheny Mountains (1802-1804). There are several major access points in Green County or you can begin paddling below the dam at Green River Lake. Trips vary from two hours, half a day, whole day or overnight. There is even an option to canoe all the way to Mammoth Cave. For scheduling canoe trips, contact (270) 789-2956. For cabin reservations, contact (270) 932-9658.

Heritage Festival & Rendezvous - The Green County Historical Society hosts the Heritage Festival & Rendezvous each October along the banks of the beautiful Green River at the American Legion Park in Greensburg. The past truly comes alive as we offer living history exhibits, including Native American, pre-1840 and Civil War camps. Enjoy Native American drum & dance, Civil War Era music & poetry, and a pioneer worship service on Sunday at our Straw Bale Theatre. A
