VISITOR ATTRACTIONS

Atkinson-Griffin Log House served as a Confederate hospital after the Battle of Tebbs Bend, where Confederate General John Hunt Morgan began his 1863 raid into Indiana and Ohio. Today the restored structure has a battle diorama and Kentucky folk architecture exhibit (free, MD-LD daily 8-6, LD-MD M-F 8-4 EST, 270-465-4463, cabin not handicapped accessible). A driving tour of the battle sites begins at the visitor center.

The Friendship Schoolhouse - The Friendship School was built in Taylor County about 1918 by residents of the Bengal community. It was located on the farm of Theodore and Ellen Cowherd approximately 8 miles from its present location.

At different periods of its existence the class size may have varied from as small as eight to as large as forty students. The Friendship School now is both a museum and a classroom. Located behind the Taylor County High School at 300 Ingram Avenue, Campbellsville, KY. Open the first Sunday afternoon of each month from 1:00 - 4:00 pm or by appointment. 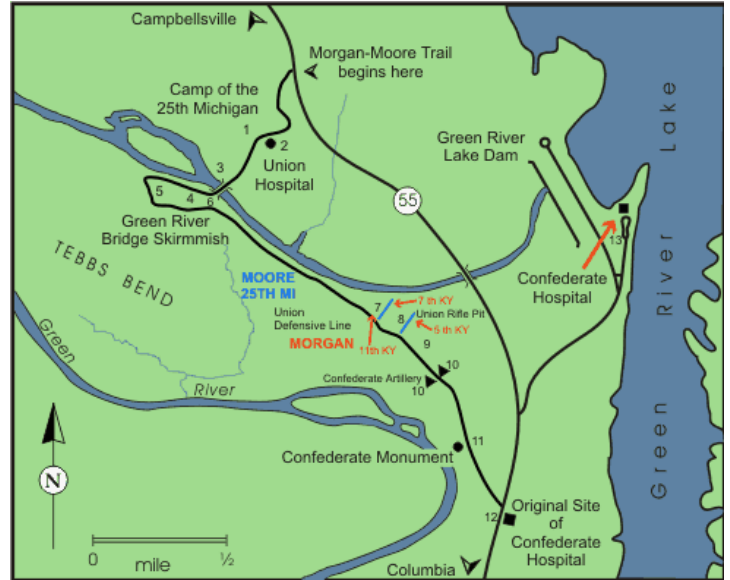
Green River Lake - Green River Lake is a haven for the water sport and fishing enthusiast as well as the vacationer that just wants to get away from the hustle and bustle of every day life. This 8,200-acre lake offers over 33 miles of picture perfect water lying between 250 miles of shoreline. With an average depth of 50 feet and at its widest point 1 mile across, it is just perfect for fishing, skiing and riding your personal watercraft or just relaxing in one of the many houseboats, small craft, floating cabins, and condominiums available for rent.

Jacob Hiestand House - Built in 1823, the Jacob Hiestand House was one of only 12 German stone houses in the state, among only two still standing in Taylor County, until it was dismantled for the construction of a shopping center on the KY-210/U.S. Hwy 68 intersection. It was the only stone house in the region that was not Scotch-Irish. The house was constructed under the fine quality, hand tooled masonry work rarely equaled in the 18th or 19th century domestic American architecture. The stones were moved to a different location on KY 210 and the house has been restored and is being used as a tourist attraction for Taylor County. Tebbs Bend Civil War Tour - The Battle of Tebbs Bend at Green River Bridge is a well-known portion of Taylor County's history. Col. Orlando H. Moore's men were from Michigan and some Taylor Countians served under Confederate General John Hunt Morgan. Unfortunately for Morgan, history saw a stunning Union victory at the Battle of Tebbs Bend on Green River.
