## VISITOR ATTRACTIONS

**Bedford Inn** - Turn-of-the-century inn featuring bed & breakfast accommodations and gift shop. 561 West Street, Bedford. (502) 255-7888. [www.trimblecounty.com/bedfordinn](http://www.trimblecounty.com/bedfordinn)

**Bray's Market House, Orchard & Farm** - West of Bedford on US 42. Fruits, vegetables and plants in season. They also have homemade bakery goods and delicious homemade ice cream made with fresh fruits.

**Bray's Ridge Road to Wise's Landing Scenic Drive** - Start at the Bray's Market house two (2) miles west of Bedford on US 42W. Turn onto Bray's Ridge Road, follow it till it stops at Wises Landing Road, (the last part of this road' is narrow and crooked as you go down the hill Drive Carefully!) Turn right and go through Wise's Landing. For a shorter trip follow KY 754 back to Bedford or if you would like more beauty turn left at the end of the LG&E power plant and follow the road to the intersection of KY 625. Turn left and follow it to US 421 at Milton.

**Callis Orchard** - Roadside stands north of Bedford on US 421. Seasonal u-pick berries, vegetables, fruits, flowers and plants.

**Niles Brays Market House** - Roadside stands 1 mile north of Bedford on US 421.



**Old Stone Jail & Trimble County Courthouse** - Bedford is the site of the Old Stone Jailhouse, standing on the courthouse lawn, where the abolitionist Delia Webster, of the Underground Railroad, was imprisoned prior to being placed on a horse and sent north.

**Preston Plantation** - Re-enactments from the 1800s, speakers, arts workshop. 341 Watson Landing Road, Bedford.

**Trimble County Cardinal Hills Golf Course** - Just south of Bedford, this 18-hole course offers a challenging course for any golfer.
